Health

54% are concerned the Government scrapped Australia's first Surgery Wait Time Guarantee

69% rate our local health services as good or very good

76% are satisfied with the level of access to health services



Cost of Living

90% are concerned the Government will increase our State debt and cost of living

76% are concerned about the Government lifting the price freeze on family car registrations

60% have had to cut items from their weekly budget to cover rising costs

81% feel like the cost of living has increased beyond wage growth over the past 5 years

88% think the Government can affect the cost of living

81% think the Government should make budget cuts to reduce debt and address the cost of living



Law and Order

81% oppose the scrapping of the LNP's successful criminal gang laws

93% support tougher measures to deal with domestic violence offenders

85% think more Police on the beat is an important priority

61% feel safe in our community

83% are concerned about hooning and graffiti

86% support tougher measures for juvenile offenders

90% think there should be tougher penalties for those convicted for antisocial and drunken behaviour

95% support tougher measures such as GPS monitoring to deal with dangerous sex offenders



Environment

48% think the Government is doing enough to protect the Great Barrier Reef

64% would be in favour of a cruise ship terminal on the Gold Coast if it met environmental approvals

73% would support a cableway in Springbrook if it met environmental approvals

Jobs and the Economy

- 65% feel the Queensland economy is in a strong position
- 39% feel their work-life balance has shifted over the last 5 years
- 86% think the high level of State Government debt is a problem
- 88% think the State Government further increasing debt is a problem
- 79% are concerned the Government won't build vital infrastructure because of our State debt



Communities

- 81% support Government funding for free legal support services for domestic violence victims
- 89% support better management of public housing
- 63% support Government funding to make children's sport more affordable

Education

- 61% are not satisfied with class sizes in our local area
- 81% are in favour of a national curriculum
- 76% support returning decision-making power back to local principals and parents
- 66% support an increase in teacher aides for prep
- 82% think Queensland's literacy and numeracy rates need to be improved



Roads and Transport

- 65% are not satisfied with the quality of our State roads
- 56% would support more toll roads if it meant cheaper registration and fewer taxes
- 64% would like to see the M1 upgrades more than any other State road
- 54% never use public transport
- 74% use trains as their most frequent mode of public transport
- 44% are satisfied with the frequency of service
- 56% are neither more nor less inclined to use public transport based on cost
