# A plan to get Queensland working again

#### **WE WILL:**

### BUILD A NEW STATE HIGH SCHOOL WEST OF THE M1

A future LNP Government will secure the land required and begin design of a new state high school west of the M1 to support families in the Gaven and Mudgeeraba electorates.

#### TACKLE DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE

The LNP has a plan to tackle domestic and family violence, including:

- · Legislation to strengthen strangulation laws and increase sentences
- The introduction of a new coercive control offence
- · Laws to empower police to issue domestic violence orders on the spot
- The roll-out of 200 GPS-linked personal safety alarms to warn victims when a violent former partner is approaching their location
- \$2M for frontline not-for-profit agencies, including \$1M for the Women's Legal Service and Emergency grants of up to \$2000 to help victims flee dangerous homes



A future LNP Government will overhaul the child safety system and protect vulnerable kids from drug-abusive parents. A stand-alone agency called the Child Protection Force will be established by an LNP Government that will include a 24-hour rapid-response team and a new squad of police investigators to clear the backlogs. The LNP will also introduce compulsory drug testing with no second chances to combat escalating drug addiction and to hold parents accountable for caring for their children.

### CRACK DOWN ON YOUTH CRIME

An LNP Government will implement tougher laws, monitor youth offenders on bail 24/7, introduce mandatory detention for third convictions, establish a Community Payback Farm program, scrap youth bail houses, and increase early intervention with a justice reinvestment

### PLAN FOR A NEW NORTHERN GOLD COAST HOSPITAL & **HEALTH PRECINCT**

A future LNP Government will masterplan for a state-of-the-art hospital and health precinct for the northern Gold Coast as part of our plan to Get Queensland Working Again. The \$4M masterplan will get the hospital shovel-ready as part of the LNP's plan to stimulate the economy and create a decade of secure jobs to drag Queensland out of the recession.

### INSTALLING FLASHING SCHOOL ZONE SIGNS AT MUDGEERABA CREEK STATE SCHOOL AND KINGS CHRISTIAN COLLEGE
