

Gold Coast–Springbrook Road: Mudgeeraba Creek Causeway Upgrade

About the project

The Mudgeeraba Creek Causeway on Gold Coast–Springbrook Road will be replaced with a higher and wider structure.

The causeway sustained damage during heavy rainfall associated with Ex-Tropical Cyclone Alfred in March 2025 with emergency repairs completed at the time.

The replacement structure will include:

- new concrete box culverts about 2.5 metres higher than the current structure
- new pavement on approaches to the causeway.

The replacement structure, which is a Government Election Commitment, will be built upstream of the existing structure to minimise impact to traffic. However, there will be times when Gold Coast–Springbrook Road will be reduced to one lane during construction.

Funding

The recovery works are jointly funded by the Australian and Queensland Governments through the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA).

In addition to DRFA-funded works, complementary Queensland Government funding will be used to build the new structure higher.

What to expect

- Relocation of the telecommunication services in the vicinity of the creek are expected to be undertaken in late 2025.
- Construction of the replacement causeway is expected to start in early to mid-2026.
- Reduced speed limit to 40km/h with intermittent single lane operation.
- Work hours will be from 6am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday with Sunday and night works as required.

It is important to note that the work schedule may be delayed or impacted in the event of wet weather or unforeseen circumstances.

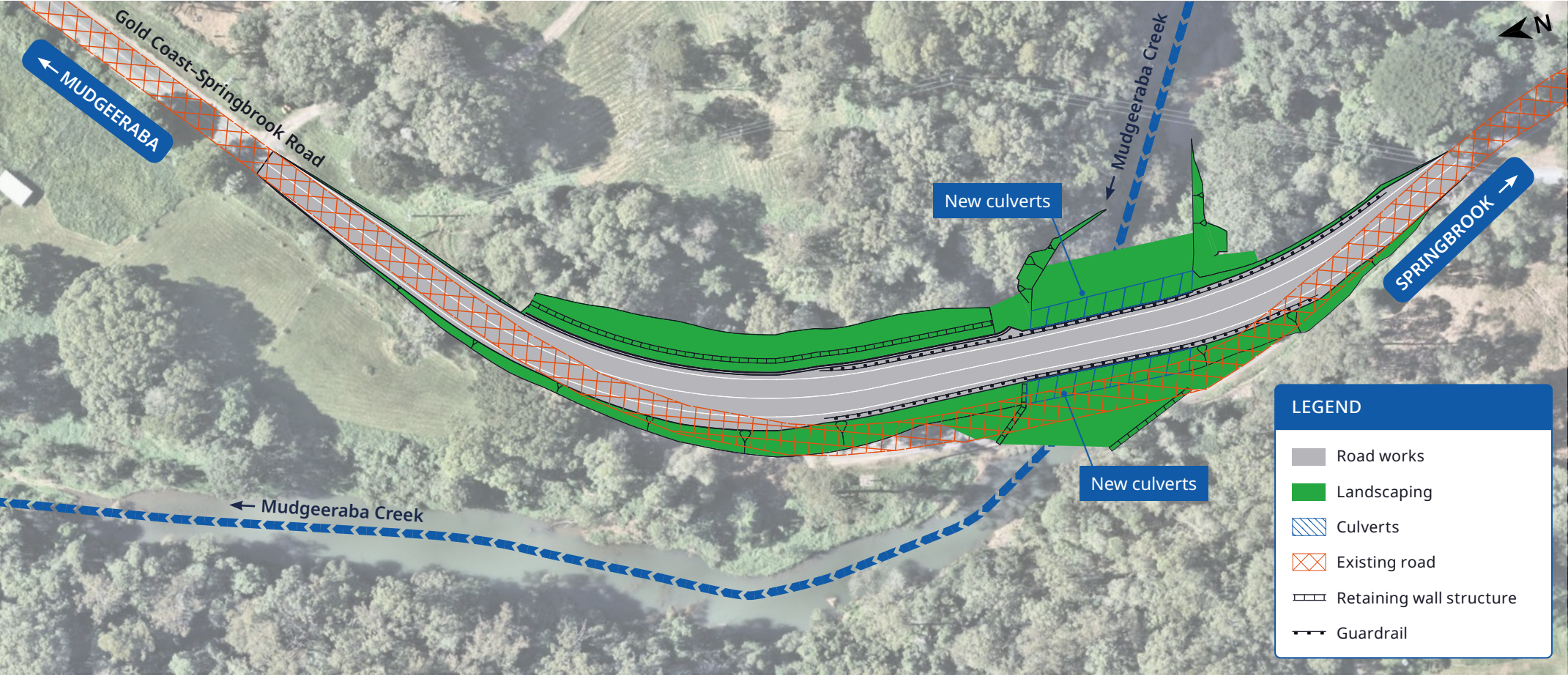
